

2017-2018 Miller Wall Elementary Uniform Policy (PK and Kindergarten)

Top:

- Long or short sleeve purple polo shirt, with Miller Wall Elementary logo (required by JPPSS)
- White undershirts only may be worn underneath the uniform shirt. No other colors are permissible. No writing may be visible on the undershirt.
- The current year Miller Wall Elementary spirit shirt may be worn on Fridays and when students attend field trips.
- Shirts must be tucked in.

Bottom:

- Navy blue pants or shorts. No capris.
- Girls may wear a navy blue skirt. Jumpers are not permissible because they hide the logo on the shirt.
- Girls may wear solid white or navy blue stockings under a uniform skirt. No other colors or designs are permissible. Stockings must cover the feet completely, leaving no part of the leg exposed.
- All bottoms must be worn on the waist. Undergarments should not be seen.
- Bottoms must be free from holes and tears, must be hemmed, not rolled or frayed on the edges.
- Jeans, cargo pants, sweat pants, leggings and wind pants are not allowed.

Outerwear:

- Navy blue cardigan sweaters, pullover sweaters, sweatshirts, hoodies, and jackets, with the Miller Wall logo may be worn inside or outside the building at all times. Hoods may not be worn in the building.
- All other outerwear may be worn outside the building only.

Socks and Shoes:

- Solid white socks only, with no other colors, designs, or embellishments.
- Lace-up, Velcro, or slip-on tennis shoes only. Tennis shoes may be any color, but not higher than ankle height.
- Tennis shoes may not be heelys, with or without wheels and may not light up.
- No sandals, boots, open-toe, open-back, slip-on, or Mary-Jane style shoes. Tennis shoes only.

IDs:

- Students must visibly wear IDs daily.

Belts:

- Not required.

The uniform policy will be strictly enforced. Uniform violations will be issued for infractions, and may result in disciplinary action. Parents may be contacted to bring proper uniforms.

I have received a copy of the uniform policy and will adhere to it. I understand that failure to adhere to the policy will result in uniform infractions and possibly additional disciplinary action.
